
Day 30

- <sup>Day 1</sup> That new believers would be nourished from His Word and faithful in prayer. (Ps. 119:9-12; Matt. 18:18-20; Eph. 6:18)
- <sup>Day 2</sup> May God bless the training of national believers to reach their own people and “all nations”. (2 Tim. 2:2)
- <sup>Day 3</sup> For partnering believers to be burdened and equipped to reach the Vietnamese. (Matt. 28:18-20)
- <sup>Day 4</sup> That the Good News would be proclaimed in culturally appropriate ways among those who have yet to believe. (Rom. 10:13-15)
- <sup>Day 5</sup> For wisdom on creative ways to get the Gospel message into every Vietnamese community. (James 1:5; Is. 55:8-11)
- <sup>Day 6</sup> That the name of Jesus Christ would be glorified through the lives of local believers. (2 Thess. 1:11-12)
- <sup>Day 7</sup> May God direct leaders to make wise and just decisions, and to serve the welfare of the people. (Mark 10:42-44; James 3:13-18)

<sup>Day 8</sup> May husbands and wives discover biblical submission and agape love that reaches far beyond duty. (Eph. 5:21-33)

<sup>Day 9</sup> That people of peace would rise up in every Vietnamese community to facilitate Gospel communication. (Luke 10:1-9)

<sup>Day 10</sup> May the sick and down-hearted turn to God for the healing of their bodies and their souls. (Jer. 17:14; Matt. 9; Prov. 3:5-8)

<sup>Day 11</sup> May believers stand on God’s Word in business and not stray from the truth for worldly gain. (Prov. 10:22; Matt. 6:33)

<sup>Day 12</sup> In a culture which is full of distrust, may the Vietnamese learn to trust every word of God. (Prov. 3:5-6; 30:5)

<sup>Day 13</sup> That believers would be equipped to handle the Word of God and to confront false teachings. (2 Tim. 2:15; 2 Pet. 2:1)

<sup>Day 14</sup> That God would call more shepherds from the flock to lead the faithful Vietnamese. (1 Pet. 5:2-4)

<sup>Day 15</sup> That the persecuted would respond in love and their persecutors would be convicted by their steadfast faith. (Matt. 5:43-48)

<sup>Day 16</sup> That local believers would be fitted with the armor of God each day for the spiritual battle they face. (Eph. 6:10-18)

<sup>Day 17</sup> That believers would experience genuine repentance and reconciliation. (1 John 1:7; Prov. 28:13)

<sup>Day 18</sup> That the lost would seek the truth and not the lure of worldly wealth and temporary pleasures. (Matt. 6:19-21,33; 1 John 2:15-16)

<sup>Day 19</sup> That the Vietnamese would realize the altars they build in search of peace are, in fact, obstacles in receiving God’s peace. (Hos. 8:11)

<sup>Day 20</sup> That new believers would boldly live and work as salt and light before their families, friends, and communities. (Matt. 5:13-16)

<sup>Day 21</sup> For the swift advance of the Gospel, that all the world may recognize the power of God to change a life and a nation. (2 Thess. 3:1)

<sup>Day 22</sup> That during difficulties and suffering, the lost would turn to the Lord for protection, relief, and comfort. (Ps. 9:9; 18:2; Nah. 1:7)
