

Cast a wide net sharing the Gospel.

- Share the Gospel with everyone you can.
- Make a name list of all the lost people you know and begin consistently praying for them and systematically working through your list for mouth-to-ear opportunities to share the Gospel with them.
- Introduce the Gospel through your testimony and touch on God's love, our sin and the need for repentance, Christ's death as sacrifice and His resurrection, our need to respond to God's offer of salvation.
- Identify the spiritually curious based on how they respond to your sharing of the Gospel.

Follow-through with the spiritually interested.

- Keep sharing and explaining with those who show some interest in spiritual things.
- Hang out together, have fun, go to parks, play games and in the midst of it all talk about God and the difference He makes in your life. Draw your friends out in conversation about spiritual things.
- Invite friends to Bible studies and use Jesus' parables to have more opportunities to share and explain the Gospel.



COMMITTED

Immediately begin discipling those committed to Christ.

- As soon as someone makes a decision to commit their life to Jesus Christ start discipling them using obedience based discipleship. If you can't continue in that same meeting, set an appointment as quickly as possible.
- Make sure they are committed and have understanding but move to baptism quickly.
- Disciple slowly for true understanding and application. Don't feel you have to complete a certain amount of the lesson in a single meeting.



CORE

Increase focus with those who are faithful.

- Give more responsibility and greater challenge to those who are faithfully applying what they learn in discipleship. These are your core.
- The core are regularly sharing the Gospel and discipling those they lead to Christ helping them to start new groups and holding them accountable to do the same.
- Intensively assist the core through friendship, accountability, teaching from the Word and insuring they maintain a proper balance in life, ministry, service and following.



CATALYST

Partner with the catalyst to strategically engage new segments.

 Encourage and support the ministry of the catalyst as a partner in continuing the work in their current segment and multiplying to new segments of the population.
